### LATEX-RUBBER MILK

#### Latex-rubber Milk

Grimas Latex-rubber Milk is a liquid used for creating special effects, particularly burns and casts in plaster moulds. It is available in bottles of 25, 100, 500 and 1000 ml. The liquid latex is white and becomes transparent as it dries.

#### Procedure

Note Do not use directly on the skin.
